The school building had a full upgrade and renovation at the start of 2023 and consists of 3 floors with 15 classrooms all equipped with TV, iPad & audio-visual equipment. There are quiet study & lounge areas with Wi-Fi throughout & a game zone with arcade games for our students to enjoy! The building is serviced by an elevator and has a stylish & welcoming reception inside the front door.

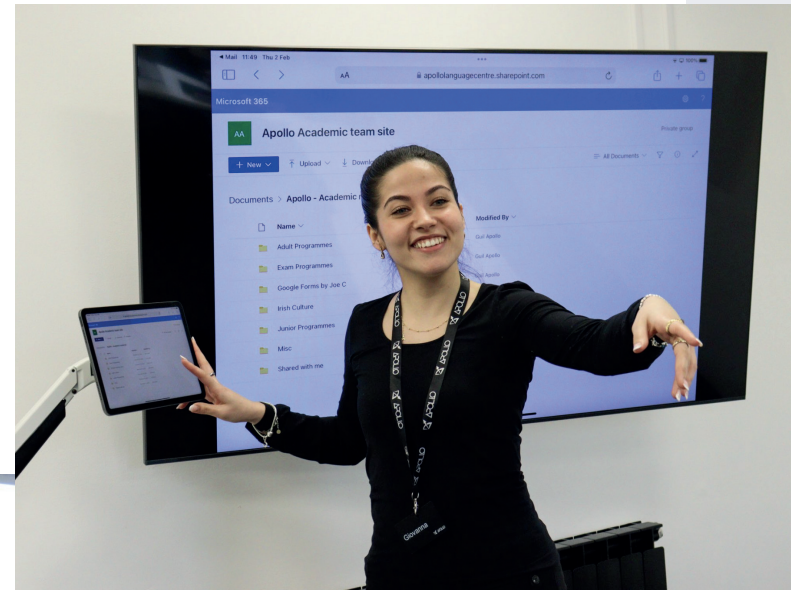

Programme

Once booking is confirmed, a detailed daily programme will be sent for approval.

Mid-Week Arrivals

Groups arriving mid-week before 3pm will be brought to the school for testing or walking tour before meeting their host families that evening and lunch or packed lunch is not included on this day.

Payment Terms

Full payment is due for all groups 2 weeks in advance of arrival.

Group Cancellation

- If an entire group is cancelled 2-4 weeks before arrival €75 per student will be charged
- If an entire group is cancelled less than 2 weeks before arrival €300 per student will be charged.

Individual Student Cancellation

- If an individual student from a group is cancelled less than 2 weeks before arrival €300 will be charged
- If a booked student doesn't arrive with the group (no-show), there is no refund and the full amount is charged.
